We have begun the process of applying for a 501(c)3 tax exempt status which would make donations from our supporters tax-deductible. This process can take anywhere from 6 weeks to 8 months. In the meantime, we are proactively seeking formation grants from local and national foundations as well as fundraising to cover our startup expenses, which include IRS application fees, Attorney fees, accounting fees, rent, insurance, and other office related expenses.
